

# Aeotec Button user guide

Aeotec Button was developed to control devices connected to [Aeotec Smart Home Hub](http://aeotec.com/smarthings) (<http://aeotec.com/smarthings>) through the use of a physical and wireless button. It is powered by Aeotec Zigbee technology.

Aeotec Button must be used with an Aeotec Smart Home Hub in order to work. 

## How to connect Samsung SmartThings Button | Samsung US



### Steps in SmartThings.

1. From the Home screen, tap the **Plus (+) icon** and select **Device**.
2. Select **Aeotec** and **Remote/Button**.
3. Tap **Start**.
4. Choose a **Hub** for the device.
5. Choose a **Room** for the device and tap **Next**.
6. While the Hub searches:
  - Pull the **“Remove when Connecting”** tab found in the sensor.
  - **Scan the code** on the back of the device.

## Programming Aeotec Button

Aeotec Button supports 3 separate button presses that can be used in an Automation in your Aeotec Smart Home hub. You can program the Aeotec button either from (1) Aeotec Button interface, (2) [Custom Automation](https://aeotec.freshdesk.com/a/solutions/articles/6000240462) (<https://aeotec.freshdesk.com/a/solutions/articles/6000240462>) (to learn how to program Custom Automation, click on that link), or SmartApps such as (3) [WebCoRE](https://www.webcore.co/) (<https://www.webcore.co/>).

This section will go over how to program (1) Aeotec Button interface.

### Steps in Smartthings.

1. From the Home screen, scroll down to your **Aeotec Button and tap its widget**.
2. Look for the 3 button press options and tap on any of them to program them.
  - Single Press (Pressed)
  - Double Pressed
  - Held

3. Under "Then", tap on **Plus (+) icon**.
4. Select one of the 2 options
  - **Control Devices**
    1. Select all devices you want to control
    2. Tap **Next**
    3. Tap on each device that you want to change the reaction.
  - **Run Scenes**
    1. Select all scenes you want this button press to run.
5. Tap **Done**
6. Test your button control by pressing the Aeotec Button.

## Replace battery in Aeotec Button

When needed, you can replace the coin battery in your Aeotec Button. Underneath the Aeotec Button is a slit where you can put any coin to twist the battery compartment open.

Aeotec Button uses **CR2450 coin battery**.

1. Use any Coin (wider the better)
2. Twist the back counter-clockwise
3. Remove the battery
4. Insert a new CR2450 battery
5. Twist the back clockwise to lock it back into place.

## Factory reset your Aeotec Button

Aeotec button can be factory reset at any time if you come across any issues, or if you need to re-pair Aeotec Button to another hub.

## How to reset Samsung SmartThings Button



### Steps in Smartthings.

1. **Press and Hold the recessed connect button** for five (5) seconds.
2. **Release the button** when the LED starts blinking red.
3. The LED will blink red and green while attempting to connect.
4. Use the Smartthings app and steps detailed in "Connect a Aeotec Button" above.
